



#### PRIVACY POLICY

# Benefice of Harston with Hauxton and Newton

This privacy policy sets out how the churches of Harston, Hauxton and Newton (subsequently: 'the Benefice') use and protects any informaCon that you provide.

In compliance with General Data ProtecCon RegulaCon (GDPR) we collect personal informaCon only as required for the 'legiCmate interest' of running the church and its acCviCes, and for the fulfilment of legal requirements. Your data will be used only for the specific purpose for which it is provided, or for which you have given your consent.

## What informa@on do we collect?

We collect relevant contact informaCon (eg email address, postal address, telephone number) necessary for the church and its acCviCes including

- CirculaCng a weekly newslePer
- Arranging services and preparing rotas
- · Organising events and taking bookings
- CommunicaCng with groups such as Friends of the church

Data is collected in accordance with legal obligaCons for purposes such as

- Maintaining the electoral roll in each church
- · Processing giUs and giU aid
- PermiVng the use of church premises

For bapCsms, weddings and funerals we will collect

- Full names and dates of birth and/or death
- Contact informaCon including full postal address, telephone number and email address

We require this informaCon to be able to fill in parish records, both the hard back registers which, when full, are kept in perpetuity by the Cambridgeshire Record Office, and for our own Benefice records. These are kept for reference and for geVng in touch should any quesCon arise relaCng your bapCsm, wedding or funeral service. With your specific permission, we will use your contact details to inform you about relevant acCviCes such as children's acCviCes in the churches, or 'remembering' services' which you might find helpful to aPend following a funeral.

### **Keeping in touch**

Where appropriate, we will ask for your consent to be contacted about further events or acCviCes that may be of interest. This consent, if given, may be withdrawn at any Cme.

# **Sharing contact details**

It is helpful for groups within the church, such as the PCC, event organisers and those on service rotas to be able to communicate with each other. Where this applies, we will ask for consent to the sharing of email addresses on group emails.

Where this consent has not been established, emails to those on a circulaCon list will be sent using blind copies.

We will not allow the use your personal informaCon by third parCes.

## Security of data

We are commiPed to ensuring that your informaCon is secure.

The Vicar and the PCC in each parish carry responsibility for data control. The Benefice, and each PCC will review annually the implementaCon of this policy, the personal data held and the consents given for its use.

Please contact us if you have any concerns over use of your personal data, or if the informaCon we hold is incorrect or incomplete.
